

Senseair Conflict Minerals Statement

Conflict minerals are columbite-tantalite, cassiterite, wolframite and metals tantalum, tin, tungsten, and gold (3TG) that are processed in areas of armed conflict and human rights abuses, in the eastern provinces of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries. These activities may fund continuing conflict.

Senseair AB does not directly procure any conflict minerals from any source and endeavours not to procure products that contain conflict minerals that may directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the DRC or adjoining countries. Senseair AB promotes the traceability of these minerals and the transparency of the supply chain. However, we are not able to directly certify the country of origin of the materials contained in the manufacturer's components.

Senseair AB is communicating our expectations to our suppliers that they have a conflict-free sourcing policy, provide conflict-free metals, and monitor their supply chain. They are also required to demonstrate due diligence in the procurement of conflict metals, show corrective action if conflict minerals are traced to unverified sources within the conflict region of the DRC or adjoining countries, and use the Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT). Suppliers must ensure that all minerals sold to or used to manufacture products for use by Senseair AB originate from certified conflict free smelters validated as conformant by the Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP).

We regularly perform due diligence with our suppliers with the objective that all minerals used from the DRC or its adjoining countries be RMAP conformant. We will continue to review and update our information as deemed necessary. If we become aware that our supply chain includes minerals from the DRC or its adjoining countries, we will take appropriate action to promptly review such findings and remedy the situation.
